

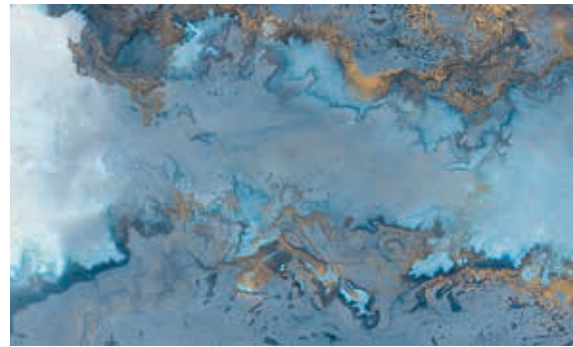

WOW ON THE WALLS

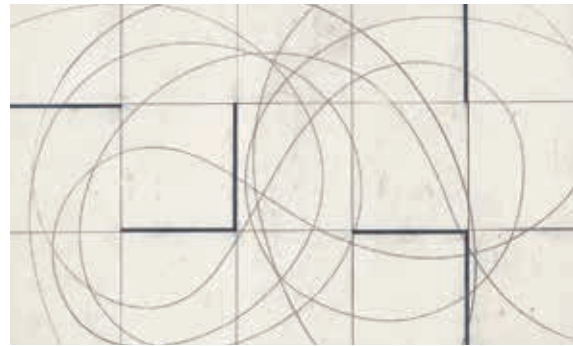

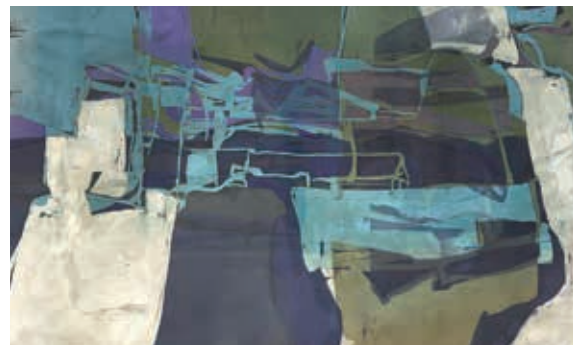

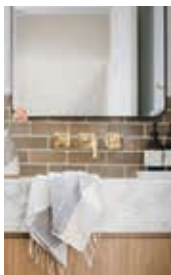

47 ARLEE PARK CABIN

Twin Citians can't get enough of Arlee Park. According to owners (and sisters) Jamie Hewitt Budnick and Ashley Hewitt Lemke, customers often say they wish they could spend more time in the vintage shop. So renovating an Airbnb cabin as an extension of the store was a perfect solution, especially since their husbands have backgrounds in renovation and carpentry. Now, the 1978 A-frame cabin, affectionately named Lilla Norr, is open to rent. Original cedar plank walls, a '70s wood-burning stove, and vintage furnishings keep the cabin true to its time period. Eventually, the owners hope to make decor purchasable so guests can take a piece of their cabin weekend home. Lilla Norr is only a 90-minute drive from the Cities, hence the name, which translates to "little north." So, a weekend cabin getaway with five of your closest friends is never far away. lillanorr.com
